Ephesians 4:17-32

- 1. 4:17 tells us that we must change the way we live our lives.
 - a. What does it mean to walk in futility?
 - i. What are some things you do on a regular basis that feel futile?
 - b. What does verse 18 mean by darkened in understanding?
 - i. Is there any way to know truth apart from Christ?
 - c. Paul says that the ignorance in those apart from Christ is due to a hardness of heart.
 - i. What are some reasons people refuse to hear the gospel?
- 2. Verse 19 tells us that a callousness describes the heart of those without God.
 - a. How do you develop callouses?
 - i. What do they do for your feeling?
 - ii. This describes someone who commits an act with no care about the consequences.
 - 1. What are some ways we see this in the lives of those who do not have Christ?
 - a. Can we find ourselves in the same situation?
 - b. What's the difference between giving yourself up to sin and struggling with sin?
 - c. What does it mean to pursue pleasure with greed?
 - i. Is there ever a time where it becomes enough?
- 3. Verses 20-24 tell us how to not have the mind of the gentiles.
 - a. Paul compares this to taking off clothes when he says take off the old man.
 - i. Does this help you better picture what it looks like to stop walking the way you used to and begin to live in a new way in Christ?
 - b. He also says that the old man is being destroyed by deceitful desires.
 - i. How is sin deceitful?
 - c. How can you renew your mind?
 - i. Compare the new mind you have in Christ to the futile mind of those who are not in Christ.
- 4. Beginning in verse 25 we see what the new man looks like.

- a. Watch as each verse gives the old way of living and then shows what we are to put on.
 - i. Replace lying with Truth
 - 1. How do we do this?
 - ii. Replace sinful anger with anger that does not lead to sin.
 - 1. What is anger that does not lead to sin?
 - 2. How does anger that we refuse to let go of let the devil have a place in our lives?
 - iii. Replace stealing with working so that we can have goods to help others.
 - 1. How is this a new mindset even for those who were not thieves?
 - 2. How does this reflect the attitude of Christ?
 - iv. Replace corrupt talk with speech that builds up.
 - 1. What does this look like?
 - v. Notice in verse 30 that Paul connects the way we treat each other to grieving the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. Think about how important unity is to the church.
 - a. How does putting on the new man help us maintain unity?
 - vi. Verse 31 gives a whole list of sinful attitudes that we must remove if we are going to put on the new man.
 - 1. How do we put each of these things away?
- b. Verse 32 tells us who we must become.
 - i. Kind
 - ii. Compassionate
 - iii. Forgiving as we have been forgiven.
 - 1. How have we been forgiven?
 - 2. How do we show this forgiveness?
- 5. If you have time check out Matthew 18:21-35 and see just how serious God takes our forgiveness of others.
 - a. How does this parable show us the level of forgiveness we have been given and the way it calls us to forgive?
